



Radiology department Bladder filling protocol

You have been given this information sheet because your treatment requires you to follow our bladder filling protocol. This is used to ensure your bladder is the same size throughout your treatment. Please follow these instructions carefully:

Start	drinking your 2 cups of water at: _			
Please	drink your 2 cups of water within 10 – 15 m	inutes,	and t	ther
empty	your bladder.			

Wait 30 minutes to ensure you have emptied your bladder before drinking the next cups of water.

Start drinking a further 2 cups of water at: ______ Please drink your next 2 cups of water within 10 – 15 minutes. You will then need to wait approximately 30 minutes. Your treatment radiographers will have been informed of when you'll complete the drinking protocol and you will be brought in for your treatment.

Please DO NOT empty your bladder during this time or you will have to start the drinking protocol again. If this happens please inform a member of staff.
